How to Use a Sauna

BEFORE A SAUNA

- Time constraints are in ill-advised: A sauna is a time for peace and relaxation, and you should leave yourself at least two hours to enjoy it properly.
- Strenuous physical activity is not advisable immediately before or after a sauna. A light meal, however, is recommended beforehand.
- Use the saunas naked (or wrapped in a towel) and sit on a towel.
- Bathing costumes may not be worn; synthetic materials produce toxins at high temperatures and clothing impedes good breathing.
- Always have a shower before entering a sauna. A warm shower followed by a good dry-off prepares your pores for sweating.

THE SAUNA ITSELF

- How long a sauna lasts is up to the individual. Normally you should reckon on around 10-20 minutes.
- Experienced sauna-goers can take up to 3 sessions. For others, one may be enough.

- Always be aware of your body's signals, at all times. Don't overdo it.
- A break is important between sauna sessions (see Relaxation Phase)

LEAVING THE SAUNA

When you leave a sauna, always do it slowly, and don't stand up abruptly. At this stage, your body and your circulation are ready for the cooling-down phase (in the open air or with a luke-warm shower).

RELAXATION PHASE

The reason for the relaxation phase is to give your body time to react to the sauna, reinforcing the healing effects of the heat. It helps your body to eliminate more toxins and work its way back to resting-pulse rate slowly but surely. Lie down wrapped in your bathing robe for this phase.

ROUNDING OFF

If you want to have more than one session, take a rest break of around 20 minutes. After a sauna, it is important to drink a lot of liquids (water, fruit juice, tea).

Towards the summits

recommended walk TO THE "AUSSERGSELL" 2,007 m



The Gsellwiesen meadows, accessible via easy paths, even though sometimes steep, are a valuable tip for nature lovers and those seeking peace and quiet. They stretch out between the slopes of two similarly high peaks of the same mountain range and rise up beneath the imposing Dreischusterspitze mountain structure. Peace - solitude and silence combine with magnificent views. Food must be brought along as there is no managed hut.

Starting from the hotel, cross the valley in a westerly direction and reach the ruins of the old Haideck fort (1413 m). Take trail 1 A and follow the forest and meadow slopes southwards until you reach the junction with trail 12. Now on this steep uphill path through the forest, follow a small river and continue upwards until the forest thins out. There, a fountain bears the inscription "all the waters of the world sing the song of joy", and it is a real joy to quench your thirst here. Shortly afterwards you cross the valley and arrive at a crossroad. Now climb left in several hairpin bends on the shady

forest path to the first mountain meadows and on a narrow path to the highest point of the Innergsell meadows, the "Rossehimmel" (2065 m; Innergsell). From here you can enjoy a magnificent view of the mighty backdrop of the Sexten Sundial Mountain, the Central Alps as well as Sexten and the Pustertal Valley. Then we descend briefly to the west on trail no. 12, cross the scree below the "Gsellknoten" and reach the "Außergsell" (2004 m) with its similarly named meadows and a private hut.

TIP: You can meet Andrea almost every day in his alpine hut, for a free donation he will gladly gift you a schnapps or a drink and he is happy to have a little chat with anyone who stops by.

The descent leads first along a wide path (forest road) no. 12 with flat ground, where path 12B branches off in an easterly direction down over the meadows called "Frohne" in the direction of Sesto, back to the starting point.


